## What is an FLM missionary?

An individual who has experienced the Holy Spirit's leading to proclaim the gospel to the unchurched and who has demonstrated a willingness to labor together with us by:

- participating in short-term missions;
- engaging in evangelism efforts (such as street preaching, witnessing, discipleship, mentorship, etc.);
- distributing FLP literature;
- presenting the FLP/FLM ministry overview seminar.

#### Are missionaries full-time?

No. All of our missionaries serve on a volunteer basis and participate in at least one short-term missions trip each year.

# How can I become an FLM missionary?

The starting point for anyone who wishes to serve with FLM is to be a born-again Christian (John 3:3-7), be a member in good standing of a bible-believing church (Heb. 10:25), and be able to obtain a recommendation from a local pastor.

## What are the required steps?

- Fill out an application from our website.
- Complete the distance-education "Certificate of Ministry" course within six months of beginning.
- Be confirmed as an FLM missionary under the auspices of FLM.

# Does FLM accept women missionaries?

The Bible nowhere restricts women from sharing the gospel. We, in fact, encourage that and support those who are willing. However, we require our missionaries to exercise authority over men through shepherding and pastoring as necessary. For that reason we cannot in good conscience forsake the clear teaching in Scripture that prohibits women from engaging in pastoral ministry (1 Tim. 2:11–12). We do, though, encourage women to serve with us as missionary workers.

### What is a missionary worker?

For born-again believers who are passionate about evangelizing the unchurched but are not led to serve as missionaries, we offer opportunities to assist our missionaries on the field.

Workers serve in a number of practical ways from general set-up and clean-up to personal evangelism and discipleship.

#### How much does it cost?

Our policy is that we cover the expenses for FLM missionaries but not for missionary workers. However, we will look at each missionary worker on a case by case basis to determine if we are able to subsidize a portion of the travel expenses.
